**Authorization to Use General Services Administration (GSA) Supply Sources - Contract No. DE-AC05-00OR22725, Activity Address Code 894777 Expiration Date: March 31, 2005**

Effective April 1, 2000, in accordance with FAR 51.1, you are authorized to use GSA supply sources for the purchase of materials, supplies, equipment, and services used in performance of the subject contract, when it is economically feasible and in the best interest of the Government. This authorization is applicable to (1) orders placed under the Federal Supply Schedule Contracts and ADP Schedule Contracts, and (2) orders placed directly with GSA, and is effective beginning with the date of this letter and ending upon the completion date of the above referenced contract.

Orders placed under Federal Supply Schedule Contracts and/or ADP Schedule Contracts (Schedule Contracts) shall be placed in accordance with the provisions of the applicable Schedule Contract and this authorization. Each order shall be accompanied by a copy of this authorization (unless a copy was previously furnished to the Schedule Contractor) and shall contain a statement as follows:

"This order is placed pursuant to written authorization from \_\_\_\_\_, dated \_\_\_\_\_, (a copy of which is attached or a copy of which you have on file or other suitable language as appropriate). In the event of any inconsistency between the terms and conditions of this order and those of your Schedule Contract or Personal Property Rehabilitation Price Schedule contract, the latter will govern."

In the event a Schedule contractor refuses to honor an order placed by you in accordance with this authorization, you should notify this office giving the facts and circumstances.

Orders placed directly with GSA shall be placed in accordance with the Federal Standard Requisitioning and Issue Procedure (FEDSTRIP).


