


Bellefonte Plant Tour



Itinerary – ORNL Students *(times are Central Standard Time unless noted)*

9 a.m. – arrive

9 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. – check in with security, safety briefing, BLN overview

9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. - tour of BLN

11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. - lunch

12:30 p.m. - depart

What to Bring/Wear/General Information

- All tour participants must be at least 16 years of age and have a driver's license or valid government issued photo identification. If you are TVA or a TVA contractor, bring your badge. Student ID's will not work.
- All tour participants must give their name, address, company, and country of citizenship to their TVA contact at least a week prior to the tour. All information has to be turned into TVA Security prior to visitors entering the Bellefonte site.
- If participant(s) are from another country, he or she must complete an international visitor form. Your TVA contact can provide this. Please let your TVA contact know ASAP if your tour has international visitors because it takes several weeks to get their forms processed.
- Suggested dress is comfortable and casual. Cotton or lightweight pants/slacks and shirts with short or long sleeves are appropriate. No shorts, capris, skirts, dresses, or sleeveless shirts will be permitted. During the summer months, it will be hot in the plant, so the cooler your clothing the better.
- **Minimum acceptable footwear is sturdy leatherwork or man made leather substitute shoes or boots that fully encompasses the entire foot with substantial soles. Substantial material is strong durable material that provides protection against abrasions, heat,**

flame, chemical irritants, oils and limited impact forces. Soles made out of neoprene, gum rubber, or other materials that are resistant to oils and chemicals are preferable.

- **Tennis shoes (this includes leather tennis shoes), shoes with mesh type material, sandals, shoes without a back and high heel shoes (shoes with heels greater than 1½ inches high), athletic shoes, suede boots/shoes, deck shoes or similar type shoes SHALL NOT be worn while on the Bellefonte site.**
- NO cameras are allowed in the plant. Pictures may be taken outside of the plant, but all cameras must be left in the conference room prior to going on the tour. This includes cameras on cell phones or other electronic equipment.
- Cell phones should be turned off or placed on silent while touring the plant.

Safety

- For emergencies, call 911 and then the gatehouse at 8776. The guards will open the gate and direct outside response personnel to the location.
- **Hard hats, safety glasses and gloves** are required in the plant. These items will be provided.
- There are a lot of temporary cables hanging in the plant. Assume that all cables are energized.
- Do not wander off – stay with the tour leader.
- Intervene if you see someone doing something that isn't safe.
- In the case of a tornado warning, the tornado assembly area is in the common zone of the Auxiliary Building Elevation 629.
- Do not drink the water in the plant. There will be bottled water available.
- Use handrails when walking up and down stairs.
- **Touring the plant requires going up and down several flights of stairs, and walking long distances without breaks. If you have any physical limitations that would prohibit you from climbing stairs or walking continuously throughout the tour, you do not need to participate in the tour.**
- During the summer months, it will be hot in the plant and we will provide bottled water before and after the tour. If you have sensitivities to heat, you should not participate.

Directions from Knoxville

- I-40 West to I-75 South
- I-75 South will take you into Chattanooga
- I-75 South to I-24 West (towards Nashville/Birmingham)
- Stay on I-24 West (it will split off about 10 miles outside of Chattanooga – left will go to Birmingham, right towards Nashville – bear right)
- Exit off of I-24 West (Exit #152) to Highway 72 West – this is the South Pittsburgh exit
- Stay on Hwy 72 West for about 25 miles
- Turn left onto Bellefonte Road – there will be signs on your right that say Bellefonte Road and Bellefonte Training Center
- You will cross a little bridge going thru the gate, pass the site sign on your left, then continue on (road will wind a little bit).

- Park in the main parking lot – you will turn left into it (you will see other cars parked here – it's the only parking lot with cars you will see).
- Enter the building at the front entrance near the flag poles. (of the main black building). Park here and enter building through front doors. Upon entering the building you will need to provide a TVA badge or photo ID.
