 * NO FIREARMS IN ARCHERY ONLY AREAS. NO HUNTER ACCESS FROM BOUNDARY



Archery only. Hunters accessing these areas must possess ORNMA Archery Permit AND DOE Badge.
 (Badges accepted - Blue-Q, Yellow-L, Gray-L, Green-Reservation Specific, White-HSPD-12)
 - Must check in & out at Y-12 AREA at intersection of Bethel Valley Rd./Clear Spring Rd.
 - Must check in & out at intersection of Mt. Vernon Rd. @ Old Bethel Valley Rd.
 - Must check in & out at intersection of Melton Valley Access Rd./Ramsey Dr.

Haw Ridge Park. No vehicles allowed. Walk-in, bicycle or boat access only.
